



Project: *Paint Final*

Paint Final:

Basic Idea of the Project:

This final is a culmination of many of the techniques that we have practiced in class thus far. In addition, the students will also employ new techniques and methods of Scene Painting. This will be a 3'x3' painting of your choosing but following the guidelines below.

Steps in completing the final project:

- 1) Prime or size your 3x3 flat. Base coat it if necessary before tracing.
- 2) Carefully plan your process. Decide what techniques to use in your painting and in what order you should paint portions of your painting.
- 3) Mix all necessary paints that you will need for the project. Keep in mind that some colors will be made or blended as you paint the project.
- 4) Project your project onto your flat and trace all of it or a portion of it depending on how you intend to go about creating your project.
- 5) Paint in the major shapes of your project and then move on to the detail. Work with shapes in the background first and build upon that toward the front.
- 6) Complete all details and shading to match the original work.

Grading:

Grading is based on two factors only:

- 80% -Accuracy of the completed painting compared to the original work.
- 20% -Cleaning all brushes, containers, trays and rubbermaid bins.
